4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AUTHORIZING LOCAL GOVERNMENT USE OF CERTAIN		
5	AUTOMATED TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT SYSTEMS; AND AMENDING SECTIONS 61-8-203 AND 61-8-206,		
6	MCA."

8	WHEREAS, Kelly Fulton, was born on June 5, 1982, in Billings, Montana; and		
9	WHEREAS, Kelly Fulton taught mathematics to students at Bozeman High School until October 2022		
10	and was tragically killed when he was hit by a vehicle while riding his bike to work; and		
11	WHEREAS, this act is intended to honor Kelly Fulton's memory.		
12			
13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:		
14			
15	Section 1. Section 61-8-203, MCA, is amended to read:		
16	"61-8-203. Department of transportation to place traffic control devices on highways it		
17	maintains and approve traffic control devices on highways under its jurisdiction. (1) The department of		
18	transportation shall place and maintain traffic control devices, conforming to its manual and specifications, upon		
19	on all highways maintained by the department of transportation that the department considers necessary to		
20	carry out the provisions of chapter 9 and this chapter or to regulate, warn, or guide traffic.		
21	(2) A local authority or other entity may not place or maintain a traffic control device upon on a		
22	highway under the jurisdiction of the department of transportation except with the department's permission.		
23	(3) The unauthorized erection of a sign, marker, emblem, or other traffic control device on a		
24	highway under the jurisdiction of the department of transportation by any other entity is a misdemeanor and is		
25	punishable as provided in 61-8-712.		
26	(4) The erection or maintenance of a sign, marker, emblem, or traffic control device on a highway		
27	under the jurisdiction of the department of transportation is subject to the rules and specifications that the		
28	department adopts and publishes in the interest of public safety and convenience.

8	"61-8-2	06. Local traffic control devices. (1) Local authorities in their respective jurisdictions shall	
9	place and main	tain traffic control devices upon on highways under their jurisdiction that they consider	
10	necessary to in	dicate and to carry out the provisions of this chapter or local traffic ordinances or to regulate,	
11	warn, or guide traffic. All traffic control devices must conform to the state manual and specifications.		
12	(2)	(a) An automated enforcement system designed to detect traffic violations that is attached to a	
13	traffic control device may not be used to enforce traffic laws.		
14	(b)	Subsection (2)(a) does not apply to:	
15	<u>(i)</u>	red light cameras attached to traffic control devices at intersections; or	
16	<u>(ii)</u>	automated enforcement systems attached to traffic control devices at railroad grade crossing s.
