1 HOUSE BILL NO. 841 2 INTRODUCED BY B. MERCER, L. JONES 3 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ESTABLISHING REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR 4 5 EXECUTIVE BRANCH AGENCIES, THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH, AND THE JUDICIAL BRANCH ON FULL-6 TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; PROVIDING A DEFINITION; PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION; AND 7 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE." 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 9 10 NEW SECTION. Section 1. Reporting on full-time equivalent positions. (1) Each quarter, each 11 12 executive branch agency, the legislative branch, and the judicial branch shall submit a written report in accordance with 5-11-210 to the legislative finance committee containing the information required by 13 14 subsection (2) based on the previous quarter. 15 (2) The report must: 16 (a) (i) include the number of vacant FTE positions in the agency or branch; and 17 (ii) for each vacant FTE position, identify the program and job title of the FTE, and the last date the 18 agency or branch advertised or posted in an attempt to hire a person to fill the position; 19 (b) (i) identify any contractor performing duties that would otherwise be performed by a state FTE 20 except for an FTE vacancy; and 21 (ii) if a contractor is performing duties that would otherwise be performed by a state FTE, specify: 22 (A) the amount paid to engage the contractor for the work; and 23 (B) whether the contractor is performing duties beyond those that would be performed by a state 24 employee if the position were filled; 25 if overtime is being paid to employees to ensure that duties that would otherwise be performed (c) 26 by a state FTE are being met through the payment of overtime due to an FTE vacancy, provide the number of 27 employees for each job classification paid overtime in the guarter that would otherwise be performed by a state 28 FTE and specify:
