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9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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11	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Agricultural data collection disclosures opt-out procedures. (1)
12	A person or entity engaged in a business involving, or as part of a business participating in, the buying,
13	brokering, exchanging, negotiating, or soliciting the sale, resale, exchange, bailment, or transfer of any
14	agricultural data collected in the state shall:
15	(a) provide disclosure in the company's terms of agreement to affected customers that includes the
16	nature and purpose of the data collection; and
17	(b) allow affected customers to opt out of any data collection procedures that result in the
18	commercial sale, resale, exchange, bailment, or transfer of the customers' data.
19	(2) This section does not apply to a person or entity's data collection for the purposes of
20	developing or maintaining machinery or equipment that does not sell, resell, exchange, or transfer the data to
21	another person or entity.
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23	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Aggregated agricultural data requirements. (1) A person or entity
24	engaged in a business involving, or as part of a business participating in, the buying, brokering, exchanging,
25	negotiating, or soliciting the sale, resale, exchange, bailment, or transfer of any aggregated agricultural data
26	collected in the state shall provide the collected data sets to the department 1 year after the data is
27	commercially viable.
28	(2) The person or entity shall pay a \$25 filing fee with the submission of the data.

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2	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Codification instruction. [Sections 1 and 2] are intended to be codified
3	as an integral part of Title 80, and the provisions of Title 80 apply to [sections 1 and 2].
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5	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
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
