9	WHEREAS, direct-to-consumer advertising (DTCA) can lead to overdiagnosis and overtreatment; and
10	WHEREAS, DTCA can lead to the overuse of antibiotics, which creates newer and deadlier antibiotic-
11	resistant strains of diseases; and
12	WHEREAS, DTCA can lead to patients pressuring physicians to prescribe drugs they may not need;
13	and
14	WHEREAS, DTCA can mislead patients into thinking all drugs are safe and effective, without providing
15	adequate information on risks and side effects; and
16	WHEREAS, DTCA can increase the cost of health care by promoting drugs that are not cost effective;
17	and
18	WHEREAS, DTCA can contribute to the opioid epidemic by promoting opiate painkillers without
19	adequately warning patients of the risks of addiction and overdose; and
20	WHEREAS, DTCA can interfere with the provider-patient relationship by introducing outside influences
21	into medical decisions; and
22	WHEREAS, DTCA can cause patients to neglect important lifestyle changes and self-care measures
23	that can improve health and reduce the need for prescribed drugs; and
24	WHEREAS, DTCA contributes to the overall commercialization of the health care system, leading to a
25	focus on health care institution profits over patient well-being.
