7	A RESOLUTION OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA RECOGNIZING
8	AND EXPRESSING GRATITUDE FOR THE RECENT REPUDIATION OF THE "DOCTRINE OF DISCOVERY"
9	BY THE VATICAN.

11	WHEREAS, as stated in Article II, section 4, of the Montana Constitution, "The dignity of the human
12	being is inviolable"; and
13	WHEREAS, the state is "committed in its educational goals to the preservation of [American Indian]
14	cultural heritage" pursuant to Article X, section 1(2), of the Montana Constitution; and
15	WHEREAS, the Doctrine of Discovery established through papal bull in the 15th century can be viewed
16	as the origin of some of the worst evils committed by human beings against other human beings, including
17	slavery and genocide; and
18	WHEREAS, the Doctrine of Discovery was inherently Eurocentric and antithetical to the view of
19	universal human dignity and was manipulated for political use by colonial powers; and
20	WHEREAS, the Doctrine of Discovery has been referred to by the Supreme Court of the United States
21	and used to justify the taking of lands inhabited by many generations of American Indians; and
22	WHEREAS, on March 30, 2023, the Vatican formally repudiated the "Doctrine of Discovery" in a Joint
23	Statement of the Dicasteries for Culture and Education and for Promoting Integral Human Development stating
24	that, "[t]he Catholic Church therefore repudiates those concepts that fail to recognize the inherent human rights
25	of indigenous peoples, including what has become known as the legal and political 'doctrine of discovery'"; and
26	WHEREAS, this repudiation by the Vatican supports the healing of indigenous peoples who have been
27	impacted by the legacy of colonialism.
