4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF MONTANA AN
5	AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE VIII, SECTION 3, OF THE MONTANA CONSTITUTION TO LIMIT THE
6	ASSESSED VALUE OF REAL PROPERTY AND AD VALOREM TAXES ASSESSED ON REAL PROPERTY;
7	AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."
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9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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11	Section 1. Article VIII, section 3, of The Constitution of the State of Montana is amended to read:
12	"Section 3. Property tax administration. (1) The Subject to subsections (2), (3), and (4), the state
13	shall appraise, assess, and equalize the valuation of all property which is to be taxed in the manner provided by
14	law.
15	(2) The base valuation of real property must be the amount assessed by the state as of December
16	<u>31, 2019.</u>
17	(3) The value of real property may be reassessed annually on January 1 of each year. If real
18	property is not newly constructed or significantly improved or did not have a change of ownership after January
19	1, 2020, any increase in the assessed valuation may not exceed 2 percent.
20	(4) After January 1, 2020, whenever real property is newly constructed or significantly improved or
21	has a change of ownership, it may be assessed by the state at its fair market value with subsequent changes to
22	the assessment made in accordance with the limits in subsection (3) and this subsection.
23	(5) At the request of the owner, the valuation must be reduced to reflect substantial damage,
24	destruction, market conditions, or other factors causing a decrease in value.
25	(6) For purposes of this section, the terms "change of ownership", "constructed", and "significantly
26	improved" may not include the following:
27	(a) the purchase or transfer of real property between spouses or between parents and their
28	children; or



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1 (b) the acquisition of real property as a replacement for comparable property resulting from 2 eminent domain proceedings, acquisition by a public entity, or governmental action that has resulted in a 3 judgment of inverse condemnation. 4 (7) Total ad valorem taxes assessed against real property may not exceed 1 percent of the 5 valuation established by this section. 6 The limitation provided for in subsection (7) does not apply to ad valorem taxes assessed to (8)7 pay the interest on any indebtedness approved by the voters prior to [the effective date of this section]." 8 9 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Severability. If a part of [this act] is invalid, all valid parts that are 10 severable from the invalid part remain in effect. If a part of [this act] is invalid in one or more of its applications, 11 the part remains in effect in all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications. 12 13 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Two-thirds vote required. Because [section 1] is a legislative proposal 14 to amend the constitution, Article XIV, section 8, of the Montana constitution requires an affirmative roll call vote 15 of two-thirds of all the members of the legislature, whether one or more bodies, for passage. 16 17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Section 4. Effective date.** [This act] is effective on approval of the electorate. 18 19 NEW SECTION. Section 5. Submission to electorate. [This act] shall be submitted to the qualified electors of Montana at the general election to be held in November 2024 by printing on the ballot the full title of 20 21 [this act] and the following: 22 []YES on Constitutional Amendment _____. 23 NO on Constitutional Amendment . 24 - END -
