9	WHEREAS, the Montana University Syste	m administers several professional student exchange
10	programs in health care fields of study, including n	nedicine, osteopathic medicine, veterinary medicine,
11	dentistry, optometry, occupational therapy, and podiatry; and	
12	WHEREAS, the Montana Legislature provides taxpayer funds to support these programs; and	
13	WHEREAS, few legislators understand ho	w the programs work and the costs and benefits of the
14	programs to the state.

16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF	
17	THE STATE OF MONTANA:	
18	That the Legislative Council be requested	to designate an appropriate interim committee or statutory
19	committee, pursuant to section 5-5-217, MCA, or o	lirect sufficient staff resources to:
20	(1) compile basic information about the	e professional student exchange programs available to
21	Montana students, including comparisons of progra	ams serving similar fields of study, for example, a
22	comparison of the health care programs under the	Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education and
23	WWAMI and of the veterinary medicine programs	under the Western Interstate Commission for Higher
24	Education and WIMU;	
25	(2) review the application and selection	on processes for the programs;
26	(3) examine the costs and benefits of	the various programs, including contributions the programs
27	have made to the availability of health care and veterinary medicine throughout the state; and	
28	(4) investigate how the programs mig	ht be improved to increase the return on investment.



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1	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Office of the Commissioner of Higher Education be requested
2	to provide support for the study.
3	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if the study is assigned to staff, any findings or conclusions be
4	presented to and reviewed by an appropriate committee designated by the Legislative Council.
5	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all aspects of the study, including presentation and review
6	requirements, be concluded prior to September 15, 2024.
7	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the final results of the study, including any findings, conclusions,
3	comments, or recommendations of the appropriate committee, be reported to the 69th Legislature.
