- > the people and communities affected by wolves. Montana FWP may has well
- have
- > plucked the livers out of these communities, due to their malfeasance and
- > addiction to Pittman Robertson excise tax & other monies regarding
- wolves.
- > This corruption at Mt.FWP is overseen by only one man , the Governor. It
- is
- > easier to buy one Governor instead of an entire legislature. The time has
- > come to take Mt.FWP away from the executive branch and hold it exclusively
- > accountable to the Legislative branch. Mt. FWP has spit on the rule of
- law,
- > why would we recognize their laws or their law enforcement powers?

- > with private land owners. They aspire to a carrot and stick approach to
- > hunting; withholding depredation control permits on private land unless
- > those land owners open their land to public hunting during the general
- > season.

- > the most productive hunting grounds in the continental United States, to an
- > agency that is so clearly on the "take" from those in the wolf protection
- > rackets? Mt. FWP was instructed in 2001,2003,and 2005 by the
- legislature
- > to file a petition to delist the Canadian Gray wolf and has now, by gross
- > incompetence, forfeited their legal status and standing if the USFWS
- denies
- > the Wyoming/Friends of the Northern Yellowstone Elk Herds petition to
- delist
- > the Canadian Gray wolf in July. Who at Mt. FWP will be fired for gross
