RE: August 2009 Rule Review

Board of Architects and Landscape Architects

Proposes to amend fee schedule by creating a \$50 application fee to sit for exam; proposing to amend landscape architect application to specifically delineate the documentation required; clarifying education and experience requirements for licensure; informing license applicants of procedural changes due to proctoring of exams being transferred to the national Council of Landscape Architect Registration Boards.

Alternative Health Care Board

Establishing fees and requirements and restrictions for inactive licensure of naturopathic physicians, midwives, and midwife apprentices.

Board of Veterinary Medicine

Proposing to amend rules to provide that fees are nonrefundable; to require attestation of good moral character of license applicants as required by 37-18-302; providing that application materials for embryo transfer technician applicants and euthanasia technicians be held for only a two year period; specifying that only board approved course providers can administer certified euthanasia technician tests.

State Electrical Board

Revising rules pertaining to definitions, apprentice registration, fee schedules, electrical applications, permits, examinations, licensure, continuing education, unprofessional conduct, and complaint procedures to accurately reflect the authority and implementation cites throughout the rules to provide the complete sources of the board's rulemaking authority and to delete references to repealed statutes.
