
Management Control: First Nation NARP






# First Nation Energy Holding Company Control and Revenue Sharing - Intermediate







# First Nation Energy Holding Company Control and Revenue Sharing - Mature









# Rocky Boys Indian Reservation



# Proposed Power Transmission Projects















# Fort Peck Energy Company

## Fort Peck Reservation Ownership:

- 2,094,178 Acre Exterior Boundary
  - 384,706 Tribal acres (18%)
  - 525,570 Allotted acres (25%)
  - 1,183,902 Fee acres (57%)
  
- 2,094,178 Total Mineral Acres
  - 318,468 Tribal acres (15%)
  - 757,110 Allotted acres (36%)
  - 1,018,600 Fee acres (49%)
