

The audio and video recordings of the Nov. 14 meeting of the Children, Families, Health, and Human Services Interim Committee are now available online. You may access the recordings from the Committee's home page, by clicking on the "Watch" or "Listen" links for the Nov. 14 meeting date. You must have RealPlayer installed on your computer to listen to or view the file.

The file is about 8 hours long, noted as 7:58:31 on the title bar that indicates the length of time for the file. You can listen to all of the file after it loads onto your computer, or just select certain topics by moving the clip position button to a specific point in the time stamp. You may need to wait for the file to load for a period of time before you're able to advance the clip position button or hear or view the recording.
