

Agency Head: Board of 18 members appointed by the governor, Mike Anderson, Chair
Don Merritt, Acting Executive Director, appointed by the Board

Responsibilities:

- Designated as the state planning body to perform functions under a federal crime control act
- Manages federal and state grant funds for:
 - crime prevention
 - public safety
 - victim services
 - court-based programs
- Provides:
 - technical assistance
 - data collection and statistical analysis
 - resource development
- Sub-grants funds on a competitive basis to 250 to 300 grantees statewide in the following program areas:
 - substance abuse prevention and treatment
 - justice system improvement
 - victim services, including restorative justice
 - juvenile justice, including detention centers, alternatives, and reduction of disproportionate minority contact
 - law enforcement assistance and drug interdiction
