I am requesting to have my disposition reviewed in regards to my parole. I was flopped for 2 years at my parole hearing when I had only 2 years and 4 months left to go on my 4 yr. sentence. At the time of my hearing I was program complete and treatment compliant. I believe that one board member (I cannot remember her name) that was in the parole hearing made statements that were biased, inflammatory and unsubstantiated towards other charges in my case that are not even of pertinence to my present plea agreement and sentencing judgement. My sentence is for aggravated assault and the judge recommended treatment specified in that judgement. It was also followed by the initial classification and I participated in those treatments and completed them. That parole board member is no longer with the board. I believe just like it has

One court has held that the standard concerning hearsay in parole revocation proceedings is not whether it would be admissible at a criminal trial but "whether the evidence considered as a whole, including the hearsay evidence, was sufficient in quantity and reliability to ensure fundamental due process rights." However the use of unsubstantiated or unreliable hearsay would be inconsistent with due process.

I am treatment complete. I have over a year clear conduct. I have never had a write up. I have had this job for over a year and never missed a day. I go to church two times every week and carry my belief with strong conviction. I believe that if I was allowed to go as an inmate worker and then resident at Billings pre-release (my home), where I have already stayed 6 months for pre-sentence instead of jail, with good work ethics and reports and no problems, that I would then be able to enter civilian life as a productive member of society and to contribute my part in it.

been written in the Billings Gazette that the board " may impose conditions that are difficult if not impossible for some inmates to meet before being paroled, beyond what is required by the sentencing judge."

I believe that I am treatment compliant and that this board member has made a decision over and above what was already decided by the qualified LAC licensed practitioners to be an adequate treatment program. Because during that hearing, after I asked what I wanted; which was pre-release and parole. I stated that I only had 2 yrs and 4 months left to discharge and she wrote on the disposition that I was caustic and argumentative. I was neither, I only made that statements IPPO Kantaman and Case Manager Christa were there and they can verify that.

Because I have been found non-compliant for not taking that parole boards recommended treatment beyond what was already found adequate, I am now threatened with the loss of my job and no chance for a pre-release or parole or the opportunity to go to pre-release after prison.





In 2011 I was sentenced to 7 years with The Department of corrections on a probation violation out of Lewis and Clark county, Helena I was required by probation and parole to take the meth intensive treatment program. I enrolled and completed the program in the spring of this year. I also completed cognitive principals of restructuring #3. This put my treatment complete and in line with the courts recommendation. On July 30th, 2013 I appeared in front of The Montana Board of Pardons and Parole. requesting parole back into the community. The ~~par~~ parole board granted parole but only after meeting the following requirements. 90 to 120 days of boot camp, 60 to 90 days of after care and 6 months to a year of pre-release. The boot camp program is a voluntary program. I have suffered with post traumatic stress disorder and severe anxiety problems since childhood. The very nature of the boot camp program is to place its ~~volun~~ volunteer inmates under stress. This causes bad reactions for me I spoke with mental health ~~and~~ professional. Hostial environments are not good for people with "PTSD." The parole board has decided that I can have a parole but only if I attend that program. Not doing the program means that I will stay in prison for the next 4 1/2 years. The prison states that they gave roughly 830 people parole in the last year. How many of those people actually left the system and how many were simply sent to another state run program. I am one of those 830 people but can not leave due

To my inability to complete a program that I was neither court ordered to or "volunteered" to attend. I have met the legal requirements for parole and have been granted a parole. The problem is it's a shell game with people's lives. They get to show on paper a parole but I don't even get to leave. This is both unfair and unjust. In a society that puts so much stock in personal responsibility and accepting responsibility for one's actions. I have done all of the things necessary to show that I can be a productive member of society. My story is one of many. There are plenty of people on "parole" that have never lost these facilities due to some hurdle that people such as yourself never get to hear about.

The statement about P&P looking for any other placement other than prison. My PO told me she was sending me to get a mental evaluation at the prison I've been here ever since.

The fact on seeing your parole file I was denied that C/M Cook in B-unit told me I ~~can't~~ couldn't see it and I heard they take a file out of it when or, is you get them to let you read it. It's not coming a person being able to read it.

Foley saying he goes with all of us and talks to us after to explain what happened in the hearing so that we understand the process and what we need to do to move forward. I was in the same unit as his office is in it's hard enough to get him to answer a "kite" let alone pull you out that's saying, "and a lie."



Here is an example of a situation that I have seen ~~in the past~~ in the past that should be fixed: A person comes to prison - the judge court orders treatment (which puts that person in category 4 court ordered treatment) It does state on the treatment priority list that if a person is not eligible for parole or release consideration until treatment is completed, that they will be moved up to a higher priority than #4. I believe this to be true. However, the problem is - if that person ~~goes~~ goes in front of the board w/o their treatment complete they can end up flopped. Normally this should never happen because a competent case manager would get w/ the person and tell them that they should waive their appearance pending completion of groups. However I have met people who have been told that it's not a big deal and that the parole board will tell them something like, some sort of release after they get their groups done. YET that is NOT what happens - **INSTEAD** They end up getting flopped for a year and have that much more time to do in prison -

- 3.) The Board says they parole 500 prisoners a year, when they send you to PRC, Watch, Nexus, Elkhorn how long does the process take before you leave MSP? Also if they say parole upon completion of ITU or SO treatment how long does it take to get into any of those classes? I do not know how long it takes I know I like 152 on the ITU list and I plan to go to pre release when I finished.
- 4.) The Board and DOC say you go to parole school and they help you put together a plan they also say you have a mock hearing to get you prepared. Ed Foley said he or IPPO goes to your hearing with you and after your hearing Ed or IPPO explains to you what just happened in there. Is any of this true please comment on your experience?
