The following list provides available programming in secure facilities owned by the Montana Department of Corrections and contracted to provide secure housing. This list is contingent upon position vacancies and hiring difficulties.

Location	Type	Title	Short Description
Montana State Prison	Sex Offender	Phase 1	Educational phase for offenders with a history of sexually deviant behavior. 16 weeks long; approximately 30 hours
	Sex Offender	Phase 2	Cognitive and behavioral phase for offenders with sexual offense convictions. 15-24 months; hours depend upon progress
	Sex Offender	Phase 2: Special Needs	Cognitive and behavioral phase for offenders whose impairments may hinder them from progressing in treatment - ADA
	Sex Offender	Phase 2: Statutory	Cognitive and behavioral phase for offenders who meet certain criteria including under age 25 when the offense was committed, victim at least 13 years old, offender takes full responsibility for offense, 'consenting' victim and no previous sexually offending behavior
	Sex Offender	Phase 3	Aftercare program with ongoing opportunities to address issues
	Chemical Dependency	Intensive Treatment Unit - ITU - Low side	Seven 15-bed pods. 10-12 weeks with approximately 300 hours of group therapy in addition to individual sessions as needed. Paid daily wage to participate and engaged in treatment activities throughout the day
	Chemical Dependency	Intensive Treatment Unit - ITU - High side	Two treatment groups comprising 24-beds with approximately 400 hours of programming over 5 months coupled with chemical dependency, cognitive behavior treatment and life skill development
	Chemical Dependency	Relapse Prevention	For individuals with previous treatment history designed to develop a specific plan to avoid relapse
	Chemical Dependency	Long term CD-ITU	Approximately 24 weeks long, but dependent upon individualized therapy for people who would likely fail and need acute treatment
	Chemical Dependency	Medicine Wheel	Officially recognized by the American Indian Development Association and incorporates Native American spiritual and cultural beliefs. Approximately weekly; 12 sessions
	Chemical Dependency	Primary Care Program	Approximately 12 weekly sessions for those with a low to moderate dependency assessment. Consists of disease and recovery basics

Crossroads - Shelby	Chemical Dependency	Dual Diagnosis Group	Program to meet co-occurring disorder needs. The group meets once weekly for 90 minutes for approximately 12 weeks. This is a pilot program on a volunteer basis
	Chemical Dependency	Continuing Care	Application of recovery principles - the group meets two hours per week and is open ended
	Programming	Anger Management	
	Programming	Thinking for a Change	A National Institute of Corrections Program developed with 24 modules that can be completed in approximately 12 weeks. Course work provides cognitive behavior therapy focused on positive thinking, social skills and problem solving skills.
	Programming	Parenting	
	Programming	Life skills	Course focuses on reentry into the work force, banking skills and public speaking - approximately 8 weeks
	Programming	GED/HiSET	The program provides testing and preparation
	Programming	Adult Basic Education	Classes designed to attain the equivalency of a high school diploma
