In addition to her work as a prosecutor, she also directed the San Miguel Resource Center, a domestic violence and sexual assault response program in Telluride, Colorado and the Ending Violence Against Women Project, a statewide multi-disciplinary training and technical assistance project in Colorado.

Currently Ms. Munch is the owner of Anne Munch Consulting, Inc. and works full time providing speaking, training and consulting in the areas of sexual assault, domestic violence and stalking. She is a recognized subject matter expert in her field, and provides her services to local, national, military organizations as well as to institutions of higher education all across the United States, Asia and Europe. She has worked extensively with the Sexual Assault Prevention and Response programs for the US Air Force, the US Army and the US Navy and has been a featured speaker at the Sexual Assault Prevention and Response Summits hosted by the different branches of the military. Ms. Munch travels extensively assisting colleges and universities, civilian and military law enforcement, prosecutors and victim advocates. Ms. Munch co-developed the Bystander Intervention program for the US Air Force and the two-week Sexual Assault Investigations course for CID Army. She speaks regularly at state, national and international conferences on topics related to violence against women. She is on the teaching faculty for the International Association of Chiefs of Police, is a visiting scholar at The Women's College at the University of Denver, and is a part time municipal court judge in Lakewood, CO.
