Greetings Megan and Committee Members -

Am writing regarding the upcoming Revenue and Transportation Interim Committee meeting on July 9th. Megan, I see your name for this committee in the recent Interim Committee newsletter, so please begging your pardon if I've gotten this wrong. HB-604 is the bill I would like to suggest be brought to the committee as a topic for consideration. This bill was an attempt to generate revenue to fund the maintenance on the paved path's that have been, and are continuing to be, built along our highways. The revenue source was using the vehicle license renewal form, similar to what State Parks is presently doing, by adding a opt out \$2 fee. The bill was amended, asking the department of transportation to create a inventory of all trails and create an estimated cost of maintenance. The other folks this is addressed to are very aware of the need, and very familiar with HB-604. This is a worthy issue that needs a funding solution.

There are a few possibilities for doing the funding, I am hoping this can become a topic of discussion and that I can attend the meeting and be available for comment.
