Montana's estimated undercount was 14,390 in 2000. With national average of \$300 per person not counted for 10 years, Montana lost a potential of **\$43.2 million** in federal funding.

In 2007, Montana received **\$10.5 billion** in federal funding. Of that amount, **\$1.8 billion** were allocated or distributed to the state based on census data such as population and income. Census based funding accounted for 17% of all federal funding received by the Big Sky state. Montana's per capita income is \$1,873.
