Gentlemen:

This is to request your concurrence that this Agency Impact Determination is appropriate for the subject project.

The project is located on U. S. 10A about four miles west of Anaconda. The work to be performed will be to construct approximately one mile of fence along the south side of the highway to prevent livestock from straying onto the highway. The location has been the scene of many livestock-motor vehicle collisions.

The project is not a major action and it is our opinion that the effect on the environment will be insignificant. There will be no alteration of land use or traffic flow patterns. The major impact of the project will be to provide a safer transportation facility for the traveling public.

The project will not have any air quality or water quality impact and noise standards are not applicable to this type of work.

We are also at this time requesting your approval to waive the requirements for public hearings and location and design approval notifications.
