

Gentlemen:

This Agency Impact Determination is being submitted for your approval on the two above projects.

F 315 (20) First Avenue South - Glasgow

This storm water outfall begins near the underpass at the intersection of Sixth Street South and extends easterly along First Avenue South to intersect with a proposed storm water drain from the north (F 144 (9) Project). This intersection or the end of this project is near the Western Warehouse Foods building.

At present the storm water is pumped from the underpass into a sanitary sewage system. This sanitary sewage system has become overtaxed during the time of and immediately after run-offs.

F 144 (9) Second Street, Milk River - Glasgow

This storm water outfall begins near the intersection of Second Street North and the Burlington Northern, Inc. Right-of-Way and extends easterly and southerly to the intersection with the outfall of Project F 315 (20) just north and west of the Western Warehouse Foods building, from this intersection the outfall will extend to the Milk River. Due to lack of available land a settling pond will not be constructed.

At present the storm drainage water from the underpass-east along US 2 flows by gravity to the sanitary sewage system at the intersection of Second Street North and the Burlington-Northern right-of-way limit. This sanitary sewage system is over capacity when also used for storm water drainage.

These outfall lines will require easements or permits for installation under the Burlington-Northern Inc. tracks, and across some private land near the Western Warehouse Building.

It is our opinion that these projects are not a major action and they will not significantly affect the environment. The projects should not significantly affect the air, noise or water quality of the area.

The work will not affect other public works activities or result in any alterations of land use or traffic flow patterns. The major impact of the projects is to provide flood water free underpass and streets. The City of Glasgow will participate in the costs proportionate to the estimated quantities of storm water added to the outfalls.

We also request the waiver of a public hearing. The flooding and sewage system capacity problem were mentioned by Mr. Walt Magill, City Engineer of Glasgow at the public hearing for Project F 155 (9), Glasgow-Northwest held in Glasgow on Thursday, June 15, 1972. Waiver of Location and Design Approval Notification Requirements and Clearinghouse approval are also requested.
