
Ladies and Gentlemen:

This letter is to inform you of the decision regarding the
Supplement to EA-93-167 which considered a change in pipeline

location for the water supply to Fathead Lake Salmon Hatchery. The Supplement was developed to incorporate engineering evaluation of the pipeline routing and provided for a 30 day comment period. No comments were reviewed during this period.

The Decision of the Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks is to locate the pipeline along Looking East Road as documented in the Supplement. This action will result in less surface disturbance and provide for easier maintenance in the future than was the case for under original EA.
