PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this notice is to state the Department's intention to issue a wastewater discharge permit to the facility listed in this notice. This permit is issued by the Department under the authority of 75-5-402, Montana Code Annotated (MCA) and the Administrative Rules of Montana 17.30.1001 et seq., Montana Ground Water Pollution Control System (MGWPCS). The Water Protection Bureau has prepared a draft permit for the facility listed below. This is a new permit for a subsurface wastewater treatment system to service a new subdivision west of the intersection of Interstate I 15 and Lincoln road in Helena, Montana. The proposed Valley View Estates Major Subdivision will consist of 26 single-family homes. The Valley View Estates Major

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Subdivision wastewater treatment system will consist of a gravity effluent main that will transport wastewater from each residence to a centralized septic tank and wastewater treatment system. The Department is proposing to grant a 500 foot mixing zone in accordance with the Administrative Rules of Montana 17.30.501 et seq.

### PUBLIC COMMENT

During the public comment period provided by the notice, the Department will accept requests for a public hearing. A request for a public hearing must be in writing and must state the nature of the issue proposed to be raised in the hearing (ARM 17.30.1024).

The Department will respond to all substantive comments and issue a final decision within sixty days of this notice or as soon as possible thereafter. Additional information may be obtained upon request by calling (406) 444-3080 or by writing to the aforementioned address. The complete administrative record, including permit application and other pertinent information, is maintained at the Water Protection Bureau office in Helena and is available for review during business hours.

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
