Ladies and Gentlemen:

A draft Environmental Assessment (EA) was prepared for stocking a pond on private land approximately 4 miles south of Bridger, MT, in exchange for public fishing access. The draft EA was circulated for 14 days to interested agencies, groups, and persons, and was posted on the Fish, Wildlife & Parks for that same period ending August 27, 2008.

One comment received from the Montana State Historic Preservation Office noted that no previously recorded cultural sites were found within the project locale. Should any cultural materials be found, we would contact their office.

After reviewing this proposal, it is my decision to proceed with this project to stock the pond with largemouth bass and rainbow trout as part of a one-year agreement with possibility of renewal.
