PHASE I WASTEWATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS: SEWER REHABILITATION AND
INFLUENT MONITORING BUILDING

June 15, 2009

The Montana Department of Environmental Quality has reviewed the above-named project. The project consists of rehabilitation of approximately 11,420 lineal feet of city sewer mains by cured-in-place pipe and dig-and-replace methods, and construction of a 12'x16' influent monitoring building at the existing wastewater treatment lagoon cells. Additive alternate bid schedules include rehabilitation of an additional 4,600 lineal feet of City sewer mains and replacement of 130 sewer service saddle connections.

Pursuant to ARM 17.40.318, the Department has concluded that the proposed project meets the Categorical Exclusion criteria of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the Montana Environmental Policy Act (MEPA).
