

NOTICE OF PUBLICATION OF CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION

WATER STORAGE IMPROVEMENTS HILLCREST AND SKYLINE TANKS

July 24, 2009

The Montana Department of Environmental Quality has reviewed the above-named project. The project consists of: 1) the construction of a new water tank at the Hillcrest site, located at the south end of Devlin Lane in Polson, Montana, to replace two old ones that will be removed, and 2) the construction of a new additional water tank at the Skyline site located approximately 100-yards south of Mission View Drive Loop and approximately 60-feet due east of the existing Skyline tank in Polson, Montana.

Pursuant to ARM 17.40.318, the Department has concluded that the proposed project meets the Categorical Exclusion criteria of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the Montana Environmental Policy Act (MEPA).
