North Side 4-inch Water Main Replacement – Water, Sewer and Street Improvements Project

March 11, 2010

The Montana Department of Environmental Quality has reviewed the above named project. The project consist of installing approximately, 19,300 lineal feet of 6-inch to 10-inch PVC water main, 1,700 lineal feet of 4-inch to 10-inch sewer main and all associated manholes, valves, fire hydrants, fittings, service lines, service connections, curbs, gutters and gravel and asphalt replacement. The project also included minor roadway and storm drain improvements. The proposed project will replace aging and undersized water and sewer mains along the following streets:

Water Main Replacement

- Alley north of Main Street (between Hoffman Street and Davis Street),
- North Hoffman Street and Cameron Avenue from Al Drive to Kennedy Street
- Bridger View from Kennedy Street to Park Avenue South
- Hoffman Street from Park Avenue to the alley north of Main Street
- Quaw's Boulevard from Cameron Avenue to Main Street
- Weaver Street from Cameron Avenue to Main Street
- Kennedy Street from Cameron Avenue to Allison Avenue
- Davis Street from Southview Avenue to Main Street
- Southview Avenue from Kennedy Street to Bridger View Drive

Sewer Main Replacement

- Alley north of Main Street from Quaw's Boulevard to Davis Street

Pursuant to ARM 17.40.318, the Department has concluded that the proposed project meets the Categorical Exclusion criteria of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the Montana Environmental Policy Act (MEPA). The Categorical Exclusion may be revoked if the project is not initiated within the time period specified in the planning documents, a new or modified application is submitted, or new evidence demonstrates serious local or environmental issues exist, or state, local, tribal, or federal laws are violated.
