

SESSION LAWS

for the construction of water pollution control facilities subject to the limitations of section 69-4808.1, R.C.M., 1947.

Section 2. This appropriation shall be allotted and used on any project on which construction was initiated in this state after June 30, 1966.

Section 3. Any moneys appropriated in section 1 which are not encumbered by project boards by April 1, 1972, are hereby appropriated to the State Equalization Aid Account for distribution to the public schools.

Approved March 11, 1971.

HOUSE BILL NO. 598

An Act to appropriate Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) from the General Fund for the Restoration of the Governor's Old Mansion at Helena, Montana.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Montana:

Section 1. Five thousand dollars (\$5,000) is appropriated from the general fund for the completion of the interior renovation of the Governor's Old Mansion located at 6th and Ewing Street, Lewis and Clark County, Helena, Montana. Said funds are to be used to restore and refinish the interior of the Governor's Old Mansion, including electrical wiring, plumbing, heating, as well as to restore and repair the carriage house and miscellaneous ground work, such as restoring driveways, walls, and landscaping.

Section 2. Funds appropriated in section 1 shall be available on the contingency they match funds in an equal amount procured from private or federal sources.

HOUSE BILL NO. 600

An Act Appropriating One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) for the Operation of the Environmental Quality Council for the Biennium Ending June 30, 1973.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Montana:

Section 1. There is appropriated one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) from the general fund to the environmental quality council for the biennium ending June 30, 1973.
