


General, State, Federal Spending By Function - FY 2011

Figures in Millions



Last week's chart showed general fund spending only, which did not totally reflect all primary funds for all of state government services. The above chart shows state government spending from the three primary fund types – general, state special, and federal special. Total spending from these three funds for FY 2011 was \$5.344 billion. As the above chart shows, over 75% of total spending is for public health, public schools, transportation (highway maintenance and construction), and statutory/transfer functions. Statutory/transfers include spending for local governments, debt service, selected retirement payments, and other functions authorized by state statute.
