


Montana and U.S. Crime Statistics

This chart shows a comparison between the crime rate per 100,000 inhabitants for 2005 and 2010. Comparisons are made between Montana crime rates and those for the entire United States. Data is from the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Uniform Crime Reports and based on data submitted by states to the FBI. Although the Montana rates for murder and non-negligent manslaughter are lower than the national rates, the trend in Montana has increased compared to 2005 while the national rate has decreased. Forcible rape in Montana remained steady from 2005 to 2010 while the national rate declined. All other categories of crime declined both in Montana and nationally from 2005 to 2010.
