



### Montana University System Student Enrollment by Institution Type FY 2001



As noted in last week's chart, full-time equivalent (FTE) student enrollment in Montana public postsecondary education institutions is at an historic all-time high. Total enrollment in the Montana University System and Community Colleges has increased from 33,659 FTE in FY 2001 to 40,961 FTE in FY 2011, a 22% overall increase. Enrollments at 2-year campuses are growing at a faster rate than 4-year campuses. The 2-year campuses reported an overall 73% FTE enrollment increase during FY 2001 to FY 2011 and 4-year institutions reported an overall 12% FTE enrollment increase over the same time period.

### Montana University System Student Enrollment by Institution Type FY 2011



The bottom chart shows how the FTE enrollment at 2-year campuses has increased as a percentage of total FTE enrollments in the Montana University System and Community Colleges from FY 2001 to FY 2011. Enrollment in 2-year institutions (community colleges and colleges of technology) increased from 15% of total enrollment in FY 2001 to 22% of total enrollment in FY 2011.
