


FY2009 Medicaid Cost (\$838.4 Million Total) Compared to Enrollment (81,610 Total) by Major Eligibility Group



This chart shows Medicaid services costs compared to enrollment by major category of Medicaid eligibility in FY 2009, which is the most recent year that data is available. For example, there were 6,126 persons over the age of 65 or 8% of the total eligible for Medicaid while the cost for that group (\$162.7 million) is 13% of the total cost, with an annual cost of \$26,564 per person. This chart also shows that children under 18 are 55% of the total enrollment, but 20% of the total at \$170.3 million for the lowest per enrollee cost of \$3,787 annually. The other annual per enrollee costs were \$20,668 for blind or disabled individuals of any age and \$9,738 for adults with children.
