
Montana Digital Academy Completed Enrollments FY 2012 - FY 2014



The chart shows the number of students that enrolled and completed courses through the Montana Digital Academy (MTDA).

MTDA supplements the curriculum of local school districts throughout Montana with online offerings including but not limited to English language arts, foreign languages, social studies, math and the sciences. Curriculum is offered for advanced placement (AP) in several subject areas. Students enrolled in original credit courses are taking the course for the very first time, credit recovery students are making up credit for courses that were failed or incomplete and Middle School students (7 - 8th grade) can sample various world languages. MTDA courses are also available to home-schooled students provided they register for MTDA courses at their local public school.



^{*} In FY 2014, the MTDA changed policy to allow students to enroll in only one credit recovery course at a time. This policy change has increased significantly the percentage of credit recovery students that successfully completed their courses. Due to this policy the MTDA saw a sharp drop in credit recovery enrollments in FY 2014.
