



The above table reflects actual and projected ending fund balance for the Montana fire suppression fund. The balance will continue to grow if the revenues from general fund reversions and the unused portion of the Governor's emergency appropriation continue, and expenditures follow the LFD fire projections of the average of the previous 7 years, omitting the high and low years.

HB 3 - 2007 Special Session

In the Septemebr 2007 special session, the legislature passed HB 3, establishing a wildfire suppression fund with a \$40 million general fund transfer for future fire suppression costs.

HB 354 - 2013 Session

HB 354 annually provides 0.5% of excess general fund reversions, and the unexpended portion of the governor's emergency fund. The legislation also provided for a transfer of excess corporate license taxes, however that expired in June of 2015.
