



The above chart represents the average monthly cost for a Medicaid enrollee by age from FY 2006-2013. Data for this chart were taken from the report on Medicaid presented to the legislature by the Department of Public Health and Human Services, [which can be found here](#).

**Blind/Disabled under age 1**

In comparison with the previous Chart of the Week, this chart shows the variability associated with the “Blind/Disabled under age 1” category. The other categories are much more stable year to year, and have sufficiently higher enrollment to counter-balance the volatility of this higher-cost population. Even

with this category included, the Total Average has remained fairly constant across these fiscal years. While the “Blind/Disabled under age 1” category has the highest Per Member Per Month cost, it also has the lowest actual enrollment.
