Per 17-7-140, MCA, the minimum balance required is approximately \$37.0 million based on the current budget. The Department of Revenue general fund budget has been reduced.

This action could result in a potential revenue reduction of \$11.7 to \$20.1 million for the 2013 biennium..

The above balance does not include any legislation to address the unfunded retirement funds issue.

The fiscal condition above includes the Governor's authority to expend \$16.5 million out of the general fund account for emergencies.
