## **BUDGET AMENDMENT ACTIVITY**

Through May 30, 2010, the Legislative Fiscal Division has received notification of 8 budget

amendments certified by the Governor since the March 2010 Legislative Finance Committee meeting. These amendments increase total funds by \$10.1 million in FY 2010 and \$93,560 in FY 2011. No additional FTE have been added. One amendment transfer existing authority between programs. Figure 1 summarizes the budget amendments certified by the Governor from the March 2009 committee meeting through June 2010.

reviewed the amendments and has raised no concerns with any amendment meeting statutory criteria.

Figure 2 summarizes the budget amendments that have been certified so far for the 2011 biennium. The various approving authorities have added a total of \$173.5 million in the 2011 biennium.
