BUDGET AMENDMENT ACTIVITY

Through October 6, 2010, the Legislative Fiscal Division has received notification of 82 budget

amendments certified by the Governor since the June 2010 Legislative Finance Committee meeting. These amendments increase total funds by \$23.6 million in FY 2010 and \$22.2 million in FY 2011. They add 1.83 FTE in FY 2010 and 46.74 FTE in FY 2011. Two amendments transfer existing authority between programs, five move existing authority between expenditure categories, four extend existing authority, and one adds FTE without adding spending authority. Figure 1 summarizes the

budget amendments certified by the Governor from the June 2010 committee meeting through October 6, 2010.

Each amendment, along with a brief explanation, is summarized in the attached table. Staff has

reviewed the amendments and has raised no concerns with any amendment meeting statutory criteria.

Figure 2 summarizes the budget amendments that have been certified so far for the 2011 biennium. The various approving authorities have added a total of \$222.5 million in the 2011 biennium.
