BUDGET AMENDMENT ACTIVITY

As of June 11, 2009, the Legislative Fiscal Division has received notification of 79 budget amendments certified by the Governor since between the November 2008 Legislative Finance Committee meeting and the start of the legislative session, and since the Senate Finance and Claims took action on HB 4. These amendments increase total funds by \$66.5 million in FY 2009, \$2.5 million in FY 2010 and \$2.2 million in FY 2011. An additional 15.56 FTE in FY 2009, 14.26 FTE in FY 2010, and 4.10 FTE in FY 2011 have also been added. Ten amendment

transfers existing authority between expenditure categories or between organizational units and three extend previously approved amendment authority. Figure 1 summarizes the budget amendments certified by the Governor from the November 2008 committee meeting through June 10, 2009. HB 4 added an additional \$4.6 million for FY 2009.

Each amendment, along with a brief explanation, is summarized in the attached table. Staff has reviewed the amendments and has raised no concerns with any amendment meeting statutory criteria.

Figure 2 summarizes the budget amendments that have been certified for the 2009 biennium. The various approving authorities have added a total of \$159.0 million in the 2009 biennium.
