Session Law Citation: Chapter 354, Laws of 1993

The Legislative Oversight Committee on Montana-ARCO Litigation is made up of two senators and two representatives, appointed by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House, respectively.

This Committee meets with the Montana Department of Justice's Natural Resource Damage Program to be briefed on the progress of the litigation and negotiations between the State of Montana and Atlantic-Richfield Corporation regarding natural resource damages in the Clark Fork River Basin. The Committee is also briefed on plans for the appropriate use of the money received by the state as a result of the litigation.
