With Gov. Rounds' signature of S.B. 180 the other day there are now 13 state file freeze laws. Two other states are awaiting gubernatorial action, Utah and Wisconsin. The Utah bill will not go in to effect until 2008. Like the Montana draft bill discussed earlier this year, it stands with Utah and New Jersey as beyond well out of line in what other states have done and it stands as only as theory and not practical since none of the off-the-mark provisions in either state are in effect yet.
