

Description of Photographs of Belt Creek

1. Belt Creek just upstream from the town.
2. The "Rusty Ditch" that runs adjacent to Castner Park in Belt. The building in the background is the city library.
3. This is the 1st source of contamination viewed from the east bank of Belt Creek.
 - 3A. 1st source as viewed from the west bank.
 - 3B. Looking downstream from 1st contamination point
 - 3C. Close up picture of contamination.
4. "Milky" color of contamination merges with clear creek water.
5. The "Swimming Hole"!
6. Just down stream from the swimming hole is the influent acid mine water.
7. Acid mine water has stained the creek bed orange.
8. V-Notch Weir Gauge. 125 gallons per minute. 180,000 gallons per day!
9. Ditch where mine water makes its way to Belt Creek.
10. Downtown Belt. Water is murky. Creek bed is orange.
11. Lewis Coulee mine drainage into Belt Creek.
12. Belt Creek as it leaves Belt, headed north to the Missouri River.
