AGENCY IMPACT DETERMINATION

The Solid Waste Management Bureau has conducted an environmental review of Jenkins Garage and Wrecking Facility.

The motor vehicle wrecking facility is located next to Highway 10 West on the southwest edge of the city of Three Forks. The size of the facility is 140 feet X 150 feet, covering lots 7, 8, and 9 of block 27.

A board fence constructed of 1 X 8's, 8 feet high, is in place around the facility, which is in compliance with the shielding requirements set forth in Rule 16-2.14(2)-S14261, Motor Vehicle Wrecking Facilities.

The Solid Waste Management Bureau has the responsibility of approving any new wrecking facility location before a license will be issued. The disposal site location was inspected on January 16, 1975 by a representative of this office and approval granted on February 21, 1975.

The Solid Waste Management Bureau will periodically inspect Jenkins motor vehicle wrecking facility for compliance with all applicable laws and regulations governing such operations.

After careful review of the wrecking facility location, our conclusion is that this facility will not have a significant impact on the area.
