AGENCY IMPACT DETERMINATION

The Solid Waste Management Bureau has conducted an environmental review of Rodney Monaghan's motor vehicle wrecking facility, Clark Fork Wrecking, Superior, Montana.

The motor vehicle wrecking facility is located approximately one-half mile north of Lozeau on the west side of Interstate 90. There are twenty-two acres in the tract, but only a small portion has been cleared to conduct the operation.

The facility will be naturally screened from public view by the forest vegetation, providing Mr. Monaghan places the junk vehicles in the specific area that is not visible from the adjacent Interstate 90. If advantage is not taken of the natural vegetation, shielding must be accomplished in compliance with Rule 16-2.14(2)-S14261, Motor Vehicle Wrecking Facilities.

The Solid Waste Management Bureau will periodically inspect the motor vehicle wrecking facility for compliance with all the applicable laws and rules governing such operations.

The Solid Waste Management Bureau has the responsibility of approving applications to operate a motor vehicle wrecking facility, along with the approval of the facility site location and the method of shielding, before a license will be issued. The site location and shielding by natural forest vegetation was inspected and approved by a representative of this office on April 7, 1975.

After careful review of the location and the natural shielding from public view, our conclusion is that the wrecking facility will not have a significant impact on the area.


