AGENCY IMPACT DETERMINATION

The Solid Waste Management Bureau has conducted an environmental review of Mr. George Metzger's motor vehicle wrecking facility in Laurel.

The motor vehicle wrecking facility is located on the northeast corner of Laurel in the Magnus Subdivision. A small fenced-in area behind Mr. Metzger's automobile repair shop is being used for the facility.

The facility is shielded with a wooden fence which is in compliance with the requirements set forth in Rule MAC 16-2.14(2)-S14261, Motor Vehicle Wrecking Facilities.

The Solid Waste Management Bureau will periodically inspect the motor vehicle wrecking facility for compliance with all the applicable laws and rules governing such operations.

The Solid Waste Management Bureau has the responsibility of approving applications to operate a motor vehicle wrecking facility, along with the approval of the facility site location and the method of shielding, before a license will be issued. The site location and shielding were inspected and approved by a representative of this office on November 3, 1975.

After careful review of the location and the shielding from public view, our conclusion is that the wrecking facility will not have a significant impact on the area.
