AGENCY IMPACT DETERMINATION

The Solid Waste Management Bureau has conducted an environmental review of a proposed motor vehicle wrecking facility in Cascade County. The facility is to be located in the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 10, Township 19 North, Range 6 East, M.P.M., Cascade County. It is to be owned and operated by Howard K. Lovett.

The area to be used for the wrecking operation is approximately ten acres in size. Attached is a map showing the exact location. Screening of the yard will be accomplished by board fences built on at least two sides of the facility. Construction of these fences will effectively shield the junk vehicles from public view. The shielding must be accomplished in accordance with Rule MAC 16-2.14(2)-S14261, Motor Vehicle Wrecking Facilities.

The Solid Waste Management Bureau will periodically inspect the motor vehicle wrecking facility for compliance with the applicable laws and rules governing such operations.

The Solid Waste Management Bureau has the responsibility of approving the proposed location and plan for shielding before a license will be issued. The facility site was inspected by a representative of this office on July 15, 1975 and field approval granted on that date, provided the site be properly screened.

After careful review of the motor vehicle wrecking facility site location, our conclusion is that the facility location and operation will not have a significant impact on the area.
