Description of Proposed Action:

Pelican Point FAS parking and boat ramp approach

Finding of No Significant Impact:

Based on the analysis in the EA, I find the project as proposed to be the preferred alternative. These improvements will greatly enhance the safe use of the Pelican Point Fishing Access Site. Repaired parking and ramp approach will improve safety of people using the ramp.

Minor changes in wording to better clarify the project were made based on comments received from in-house agency review. With these changes the EA will be accepted as the final EA.

I have reviewed the EA and applicable laws, regulations, and policies and have determined that this action will not have a significant effect on the human environment. Therefore, an environmental impact statement will not be prepared.

This action is subject to appeal, which must be submitted to the FWP Director in writing, and postmarked within 30 days of the date on this decision notice. The appeal must specifically describe the basis for the appeal, explain how appellant has previously commented to the Department or participated in the decision-making process, and lay out how FWP might address the concerns in the appeal.
