## **FWP TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING ABOUT PROPOSED SHIELDS RIVER FISHING ACCESS SITE ACQUISITION**

**BOZEMAN—**

A public meeting will be held by Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks (FWP) in Livingston on October 19<sup>th</sup> to facilitate discussion about the potential acquisition of a Fishing Access Site (FAS) on the Shields River.

FWP is currently considering accepting a donation of a 23.6-Acre parcel of land, along Highway 89, South of Clyde Park, from a private landowner for use as an FAS. At this meeting, FWP staff will discuss the proposed acquisition and its potential development and use with attendees. The public is invited.
