Type and Purpose of Action: The applicant has proposed to increase the acreage of his permit. This change would increase the volume of material that can be removed from the site from 190,000 to 390,000 cubic yards, would change the final date of reclamation from December 2015 to November 2020, would make necessary changes on the permit map, and would change the bond accordingly. All other aspects of the operation would remain the same. The attached map below shows the new boundaries of the permit and the older 1999 permit boundary. It also shows the location of the Ravalli County gravel permit adjacent to this permit on the south side.

Potential Impacts and Mitigation: It is expected that impacts associated with this proposal will mimic those identified in the original EA dated September 1999.

Public involvement: Ravalli County has signed a new Zoning Form indicating that there is no zoning in effect in this area other than subdivision development minimums of 2 acres per lot.
