The mine operator is proposing to include an additional piece of land within the mine permit boundary. The land consists of approximately 63.5 acres. The land is a narrow linear strip surrounding a road providing access to the air intake portal.

Potential Impacts and Mitigation Measures:

This action proposes to expand the mine permit boundary. Expanding the boundary to include the road area will allow the DEQ to appropriately permit how the road is constructed, maintained and later reclaimed. The road and associated construction impacts, have been, or will be, addressed in the EA for those minor revisions.
