COMMUNICATIONS AND PETITIONS

**A JOINT PROCLAMATION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE
OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA**

WHEREAS, In August of 1949, a 15 member crew of Forest Service smokejumpers parachuted into Mann Gulch on the Helena National Forest to suppress a small wildfire burning 25 miles north of Helena in the remote Gates of the Mountains Wild Area.

WHEREAS, events of this date describe that the fire eventually blew up and entrapped the 15 smokejumpers and another firefighter who had joined up with their crew. Only three of the men escaped the fire with their lives.

WHEREAS, the citizens of the State of Montana want to recognize on local, regional, and national levels, the 50th anniversary of the Mann Gulch Fire of August 5, 1949, and the year-long commemorative events planned to mark the anniversary.

WHEREAS, to heighten consciousness of the story of the Mann Gulch Fire and the 13 men who died there.

WHEREAS, to ensure that the memory of these men and the sacrifice they made 50 years ago for the State of Montana and their country is not forgotten.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

This body recognizes August 5, 1999 as "The Mann Gulch 50th Anniversary."
This tragic day in 1949 was the end of a race that 13 firefighters could not win.
The repercussions from this incident shall be remembered by a grateful state and nation.

This proclamation is signed by Senators Crippen and Doherty and Representatives Mercer and Swanson.

(2) Based on documentation to be submitted by each agency, the budget director shall determine the number of positions and employees (full-time equivalents) of each agency or program thereof prior to preparation of the executive budget and before the beginning of each fiscal year. At any time, upon the request of the agency, the budget director may amend the number of positions or employees (full-time equivalents) in any agency or program thereof.

(3) This section does not limit legislative authority to amend the determinations of the department or the budget director.

(4) (a) By September 1, 2000, each agency other than those referred to in subsection (4)(b) shall identify the specific positions that are to be removed from the list of authorized positions provided for in 2-18-206. The number of positions that are to be removed must be sufficient to equal a reduction of 3% of the amount of personal services appropriated for fiscal year 2001. Each agency and the budget director shall use the modified list of authorized positions in the preparation of the executive budget. The list prepared pursuant to this subsection must be provided to the legislative fiscal analyst and the office of budget and program planning.

(b) Subsection (4)(a) does not apply to an agency that has less than 85 authorized positions, the legislative branch, the judicial branch, any program with 50% or more elected officials, or the university system."
