COMMUNICATIONS AND PETITIONS

**A PROCLAMATION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF
REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA**

WHEREAS, from 1993 to 1996, Dr. Jeff Baker served as Commissioner of Higher Education for the Montana University System. In addition to his position as Commissioner, Dr. Baker served as chief executive officer for Montana's six 4-year institutions and five colleges of technology, as chief executive officer of the Montana Guaranteed Student Loan program, and as president of the Montana Higher Education Student Assistance Corporation. Prior to his selection as Commissioner, Dr. Baker served from 1988 to 1993 as dean and vice president for academic affairs at Carroll College in Helena, Montana. From 1996 until the time of his death, Dr. Baker served as president of Luther College in Decorah, Iowa; and

WHEREAS, as Commissioner of Higher Education, Dr. Baker was responsible for planning and implementing the restructuring of the Montana University System and worked diligently to establish the Montana Tuition Assistance program, which provides cash assistance to low-income working students enrolled in the Montana University System. In tribute to his commitment to the needs of these students, the Board of Regents has appropriately renamed its scholarship program the "Baker grants"; and

WHEREAS, as the primary representative of the Montana University System before the Senate and House of Representatives, Dr. Baker confronted many contentious and controversial issues, yet consistently treated everyone with respect and dignity. Before legislative committees, Dr. Baker earned a reputation for honesty, forthrightness, good humor, and never-ending enthusiasm and together with his wife, Shirley, bestowed

kindness and graciousness on all who came to know them; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Jeff Baker was a true friend to the Legislature and the citizens of Montana and through his unselfish service made Montana a better place.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: that the Legislature hereby honor Dr. Jeff Baker for his dedicated service, scholarship, and unwavering commitment to students and to the improvement of education in the State of Montana.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the original of this resolution be delivered to the Board of Regents of the Montana University System and that a copy be delivered to the family of Dr. Jeff Baker.
